Dear Clergy and Wardens,

The Committee on Nominations is seeking nominations for the following Diocesan Positions as called for in our Constitution and Canons. Please prayerfully consider which eligible voters in your congregation would be good candidates to serve in these important positions. Our Rules of Order state that there will be no nominations from the floor. **All nominations are due no later than September 7, 2018.**

**Youth Delegates to Diocesan Synod:** Four at-large Youth Delegates, age 16-22, drawn from eligible voters of four different Congregations and Missions of the Diocese will be appointed by the Standing Committee to serve for one year. (Constitution, Article IV, Sec. 2E and Canons Title IA, Canon 2, Sec. 3 C) Youth delegates have voice and vote.

**Standing Committee:** Two clergy and two laity shall be elected to serve three-year terms. Lay Members of the Standing Committee must be Eligible Voters in a Congregation or Mission of the Diocese who have been confirmed or received by a Bishop of the Province or another province of the Anglican Communion. Clergy members of the Standing Committee must be under the authority of the Bishop. The Standing Committee meets on the second Wednesday of the month from 2:00-4:30 pm. (Constitution, Article VIII, and Canons, Title IA, Canon 3)

**Committee on Constitution and Canons:** Three members, laity or clergy, shall be elected to serve three-year terms. (Constitution, Article IX and Canons Title IA, Canon 5, Section 3)

**Delegates to Provincial Assembly June 17-19, 2019, Plano Texas:** Five clergy and four lay delegates can be elected to represent the Diocese of the Mid-Atlantic at the Provincial Assembly. In addition we may elect and send five youth delegates. Youth must be at least 16 years of age but not older than 26 at the time the Assembly convenes. (ACNA Canons Title 1 Canon 2 Section 3). The number of delegates to the ACNA Provincial Assembly is determined by our total ASA compiled from the annual Congregational Reports. (Our delegates to Provincial Council are automatically delegates to Provincial Assembly, giving us a total of six clergy and six lay delegates)
